- Application Process
 - ESSER II application was due 6/30/2021
 - Eligible reimbursement period 3/13/2020 through 9/30/2023

Application/Funding

- Application Process
 - ESSER III application due 6/30/2022
 - Eligible reimbursement period 3/13/2020 through 9/30/2024

Application/Funding

- ISBE Funding Expenditure Reports
 - Completed at least quarterly via IWAS System
 - Final report due no later than 90 days after grant end date
- Cash on Hand-60 days of float
- Selling Bonds
- Short term borrowing



- School facility repairs and improvements to enable operation of schools to reduce risk of virus transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards, and to support student health needs.
- Inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, replacement, and upgrade projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities, including mechanical and non-mechanical heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems, filtering, purification and other air cleaning, fans, control systems, and window and door repair and replacement.





 - Floating Bonds; Passage




- Risk Management
 - Setting the time line
 - Skill set of District staff
 - Teacher/Building Input during design
 - Site access/building safety
 - Controlling the budget
 - Board Approval
 - Completing on time



- Setting the Timeline
 - Programming 3 months
 - Space Planning 3 months
 - Schematic Design 3 months (many factors drive)
 - Design Development 3 months (many factors drive)
 - Construction Documents 3 months (many factors drive)
 - Bid Time Frame 2 months
 - Board Approval 1-2 months
 - Physical Construction 4-12 months


